### **Brief Academic/Professional Biography**

Joined NILERD in 2015 as Deputy Director and since have been working with NILERD team members on varied funded research projects, beside's taking classes/lectures on range of M&E subject area for National and International course participants at the institute. She has more than ten years of rich experience in M&E sector.

Prior joining NILERD she has been associated with research institutions of repute namely NIHF New Delhi and IIPS-Mumbai besides working for major development partners. At NIHF she worked on a collaborative project with Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) and National AIDS Control Organization (NACO) GOI as partners, to refine and suggest new estimation techniques for arriving at precise HIV estimate in India. She has worked extensively in preparation of successive HIV Annual Sentinel Surveillance reports. Richa was also involved in the management of Integrated Biological Behavioral Survey (IBBS) of the NIHF and have been identified as lead trainer under IBBS by NACO GOI during her days with the institute. She lectured MD and Nursing students on epidemiology of HIV/AIDS at NIHF.

She had also spent number of years providing M & E expertise to National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) programs of Government of Uttar Pradesh and has worked closely with senior bureaucrats and policy makers of the State.
